Gameball Run: Thursday, February 9th @ Carper Field (Morton High School Track & Football Field)

- Registration begins at 3:30 pm. The run will start at 4 pm.
- Any student (K-12) may participate in the Gameball Run on Thursday, February 9th. For a donation of \$25 your student will get a Gameball t-shirt, runner's bib and 2 tokens for a free bag of popcorn at the Gameball Run concessions on Thursday, February 9th, and/or the MHS Basketball Game concessions on Friday, February 10th.
