



Student Supply List & Locker Information – 2024-25

Supplies

Students will not be allowed to carry backpacks around to every class. Depending on the student's Team, additional specific supplies may be needed. Teachers will communicate these needs during the first days of school. It is also recommended that all students have library card from the Morton Public Library. All Morton #709 students, regardless of address are eligible for a free library card.

Required:

Pens (blue or black & red), Pencils, & Pouch

Colored pencils

Highlighters

Loose leaf paper

Protractor, clear (*7th Grade only*)

Composition Notebook (*7th Grade only*)

Box of tissues (*give to Homeroom*)

7 – Pocket folders

3 – One subject spiral notebooks

Fine point black Sharpie marker

Earbuds (*for IPad*)

Scientific calculator (*8th Grade only*) recommended: Texas Instrument 30XIIS

NOTE: NO longer required: TI-Nspire CX / TI Nspire CX II graphing calculator (*8th Grade*)...*this will be needed in HIGH SCHOOL. MJHS has graphing calculators available in the classroom.*

Physical Education: *T-shirts are provided (at no charge starting in 2024) to all incoming 7th Graders. and new students. Extras (\$10) can be purchased by sending a check or cash to the main office or your students PE teacher. All shirts will be passed out during the first week of school during PE class.*

Optional

3-ring zippered binder

(Not all binders will fit into a locker! You may want to try it out before you use it to ensure it fits)

Lockers

General Expectations

- NEVER (EVER) share locker combination with ANYONE & only use your assigned locker
- Locker numbers and combinations are available at Registration

Locker Dimensions

- 11" deep, 12' wide, 49" tall (below shelf), 9" tall (above shelf)

How to Open a Locker

- Turn dial clockwise several times to "clear" the internal memory
- Turn dial clockwise to first number in combination
- Turn dial counter-clockwise to the 2nd number in combination (you must pass the 1st number)
- Turn dial clockwise directly to the 3rd number in the combination
- Example combination: 33-4-21... "clear" the memory, turn clockwise to 33, turn counter-clockwise to 4 (after passing 33), turn clockwise directly to 21

PE Lockers

Students will be assigned a locker and combination from their PE teachers. Students are expected to keep their belongings inside their lockers, locked at all times.
